- Hillside The western leg of the property that goes out to hwy 10 starts out elevated and slopes to hwy 10.
- Logging Potential Treed with maple, cedar, pine, walnut, and popular.
- Open space suitable to build on with minimal work
- Rocky in places
- Waterway a small drainage area in the back of the property in the spring
- Wooded/Treed 50 percent natural growth

• A1 & EP. The ep area is a small pond area against highway 10, and a very small area against the south property line adjacent to the neighboring horse pasture
